PROGRAMME NOTES

1. Feel free to bring any table games, music etc with you on the day.
2. Leaders are responsible for the welfare and well being of the members of their own groups at all times.
3. Leaders are responsible for the transport arrangements of their group to and from the Methodist Church Centre.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **Cost per person** - £4 including lunch (or slightly more for some food options).
2. **Leadership** - All groups should be adequately supervised. Each leader will be responsible for their group's behaviour and general welfare. There should be both male and female leaders for mixed groups with a ratio of one leader to each 8 - 10 young people. You must have a signed parental consent form for all those under 18 to participate, to include an emergency contact number and details of any medical/health matters.
3. **Insurance** - Please check that all your members are covered by Personal Accident Insurance under your Church's policy with the Methodist Insurance Company.
4. **Age Range** - Members should be between 11 and 25 years.
6. **Travel Directions** and parking. The Methodist Church Centre is located on Eastgate. (specifically between little Eastgate and Chequergate) at 9 Nichol Hill, LN11 9NQ. We will meet first in the Church before moving on to Nichols. Quick drop offs are possible outside the Church. For Parking we recommend the long stay off Kiln Lane near the Fairtrade Co-op Supermarket.
